After many months of wait and see, we bring you

a season of renewal which is aptly titled "New World Reawakening", expanding on last year's theme "New World."

The season opens on October 24 with SSO Musicians' Bucket List Revisited. Much of this same program was cancelled at the end of the 2019-2020 season. This concert will be dedicated to the memory of Marty Ozinga III, a longstanding supporter of the arts on the southwest side, and of the SSO in particular. Barber's solemn Adagio for Strings will be included in the program, culminating in Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture, a work which speaks to the triumph of the human spirit.

Our audience-favorite holiday concerts return to St. Michael Church and St. Francis of Assisi in Orland Park on December 3 & 12 respectively. You won't want to miss the opportunity to congregate in person again with the SSO - collaborating with these wonderful music ministries in *Spirit* of the Holidays!

On March 6 distinguished Chicago Symphony Orchestra musicians Baird Dodge and John Sharp perform Brahms' *Double Concerto*. Dvorak's beloved *New World Symphony* will be featured on the second half.

"Third time is a charm" comes to mind when the SSO teams up with the Moraine Chorale, Dana Campbell, soprano and Brad Jungwirth, baritone in *An Afternoon of Lerner and Loewe*. Twice postponed, we are pleased to include the same cast for this April 10 concert!

To conclude the season, the SSO is excited to announce a *Luncheon Concert and Silent Auction Fundraiser Gala* on Sunday, May 15 from 1-5 p.m. at Georgios Banquets in Orland Park.
